



NMHIC has some exciting news for you!

We have received a contract from the NM Department of Health that will allow us to waive fees for 2 years to subscribe to the **NMHIC Health Information Exchange (HIE) clinical portal** with a link to the **Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP)** from the patient record. **That's a \$400 per provider value!**

The State of New Mexico wants to encourage providers to consistently use the PMP to help address our opioid overdose problem in New Mexico. The link to the PMP within our portal allows any user who has a DEA number and can currently access the PMP site to simply click a link in the patient's record to have a PMP report returned instantly. No need to log into the PMP separately and enter patient information again!

Because the portal is free for two years, perhaps you'll want to consider getting both Direct Secure Messaging (DSM) and the HIE clinical portal, but at least you could have the HIE with the link to the PMP **for no cost for two years**, with an option to renew for two more at our low subscription fee. In addition to this convenience, you'll be able to see patient information from our many participating data providers.

Details:

- The agreement is for two (2) years at no charge, with renewal for two more years at our regular low participation rate, and the ability to cancel after the free subscription runs out if desired.
- An agreement must be fully executed no later than August 23, 2019 to ensure to meet the deadline for state funding.
- *After the free subscription*, NMHIC's regular low participation rates:
 - Physician groups and other ambulatory health care providers - \$150 per billable provider per year, and \$50 per provider per year for PMP access from the NMHIC HIE clinical portal. (Non-clinical users in support positions are included in HIE access at no additional charge.)
 - For organizations also using our Orion Health *Communicate* Direct Secure Messaging (DSM) service, a 50% discount will be applied upon renewal.
- The initial agreement includes train-the-trainer assistance and other implementation support to onboard your end users, privacy officer, and help desk personnel.
